This term Kindergarten have been reading fairy tales and also Dr Seuss. Here are some of our work samples . . . Aren't we clever?


















Positive Behaviour, Engaging Learners (PBEL)

RULES: 3-6 stand 4.5 meters from the goal, K-2 stand 2.5 meters away from the goal.


Kindy White Elephant Stall - Items Needed

Please make sure all items are in good condition .








Colour Our Drawing by Seth G, Elijah and Justin


