Mandarin Lessons

We are delighted to be able to introduce Mandarin lessons this year for all students from K-6. No previous knowledge of Mandarin is required as the program is designed for students with a wide range of abilities. Research tells us that learning a second language has many benefits, including:

- Enhanced literacy learning in English by developing better understandings of the structure and workings of languages
- Developing skills and strategies for decoding and making meaning from words
- > Developing flexibility and competence in dealing with language concepts
- Developing sensitivity to language with a better 'ear' for listening
- A positive effect on a child's intellectual growth and flexibility in thinking
- > An appreciation of other people and their culture
- An opportunity to communicate with people from another culture



All classes will be having one lesson per week at a cost of \$3. This amount will be included in the term invoice.
